Tapestry and Focus Children

We have now set up all children's Tapestry profiles, if you need any help or support with this please speak to your child's keyperson. We would love to see parents and carers engaging and sharing events from home and next steps activities which we can share with your children. Every 6-8 weeks your children will be a focus child, we ask you to complete a simple questionnaire on Tapestry or a paper copy and return to your child's key person. After the focus week your child's key person will arrange a 10-minute phone call with you to discuss your child's learning and development and agree some next steps for their home learning.

This will then be uploaded to Tapestry for you to like or comment. Tapestry is our main form of communication with you, please can we ask that you regularly check your child's Tapestry or set up notifications so you are aware that something has been uploaded.



Packed Lunches

If your child has a packed lunch at nursery please can we remind you that we are a **NUT free** school. Please see the picture for some healthy eating suggestions, any food that your child chooses not to eat we will send home so you can see how they have eaten at nursery. Please remember to only send in foods that can be eaten cold as we are unable to warm foods.

Please can we ask that grapes, sausages, blueberries etc, are cut length ways for safety. Thank you
