Dear Willows Parents/Carers,

I would like to remind all parents that children are expected to come to nursery for every session unless they are unwell. Children with a temperature or with sickness and diarrhoea should stay at home. We also recognise that one of the impacts of COVID-19 is on children's immune systems; this is evident this year as we have had so many children absent with illness. However, the funded place is dependent on regular attendance at nursery which we are keen to encourage. Failure to attend nursery regularly can jeopardise your nursery place.

Children whose attendance is above 90% generally make excellent progress in all areas of learning as well as developing solid friendships. In addition it is useful for children to get into a pattern of regular attendance in Willows before moving through to the main nursery.

Should your child not be well enough to come to nursery, please phone us on 0118 937 5425 on the first day of the absence. We have a duty of care to ensure the safety and wellbeing of children who do not attend nursery and have to investigate any unexplained absences.

Can parents ensure they collect their child promptly at the end of the session. It can be very upsetting for children who are not collected on time and staff have a very limited time to tidy the classroom and have their break ahead of the next session.
