## Dropping and collecting your child

Rainbow Class - we are really pleased to let you know that we are opening the nursery for you to bring your child in and hand to a member of the team. We are asking that you support your child to hang their own coat, find their name card and put on their water bottle label, before handing them to a staff member. Please ensure your child has been escorted into the middle room before leaving them. For safeguarding reasons please do not enter the middle room. When collecting your children, we are asking for parents to come in and form a queue and we will hand over each child in turn. You will then be able to collect their belongings and head off.

Snowflake Class - Drop off please come inside the gate and make your way to the main reception. Please collect your children from the yellow gate inside the car park. Thank you.

#### If Your Child Is Unwell

If your child is unwell or not coming to nursery for any reason please call the office or leave a message on the answer phone. We have a duty of care to follow up any absences on the first day so please do make this call.

## **Nut Free Nursery**

Please note we are a Nut Free Nursery we have a child and staff member with serious allergies to nuts.

#### **Donations**

We are still accepting and are very appreciative of your weekly fruit and monitory donations. £1 per week or £10 per term towards toys and materials for the children.

What to bring to nursery - Please ensure all clothes and belongings are clearly named in a <u>ruck sack or cloth bag</u>. NO CARRIER BAGS PLEASE

- Water bottle this will go home each day (please only fill with water)
- Wellington boots to leave at nursery
- Water proof jacket and trousers (or all in one) to leave at nursery
- Sun hat and sun cream un opened and named please hand the cream to a member of staff - to leave in nursery
- Nappies and wipes (if applicable)
- Spare clothes including underwear and socks

Please **DO NOT** put toys, food, medication, creams or any other items not listed above in your child's bag.

Please **DO NOT** send any plastic carrier bags into nursery. This is for safety and ecological reasons. Wet bags are an easy way to store wet/dirty clothes. They are a reusable, waterproof and leak resistant bag that zips shut to help keep odours (and liquids) from escaping.

# Focus Children and Tapestry Observations

Each small term your child will become a focus child. You will be asked to complete a simple questionnaire and then return this back to the team member. At the end of each focus week you will have a phone meeting to discuss the week and an amalgamated observation uploaded to Tapestry. Please comment or click like to say you have seen this. We ask that you then add your own observation showing something you have done at home following the suggested next steps for home learning.

After the focus week you will have a 10-minute phone meeting with your key person to discuss your child's progress. By carrying out observations this way, it means that the team spend more time with the children and our observations are more focused on the children's learning and we get to meet with parents to discuss children's learning every 6 to 8 weeks.

Each child in Rainbows will have a short settling in summary approximately 2 weeks after joining us with a follow up telephone call. The focus weeks will begin the following short term. Children in Snowflake class will have individualised settling in period.

#### Sun Cream and Hats

Hopefully the sun will continue to shine for a little longer. On these sunny days can you ensure your child has had sun cream applied just before they come in to nursery and that they have a named sun hat. We will continue to ensure the children have access to plenty of fluids and that they have shade in the garden. Thank you.

#### Lunch Boxes

Please Remember we are a NUT FREE School. We provide water for the children to have with their lunch. Please do not send in any other drinks. We are sending home any food your child chooses not to eat or if there was too much for them to eat in 30 minutes (it is not recommended that children sit for longer than this to eat a meal). We ask that you follow the healthy eating suggestions below and to only send food that can be eaten cold as we are not able to reheat food.
